



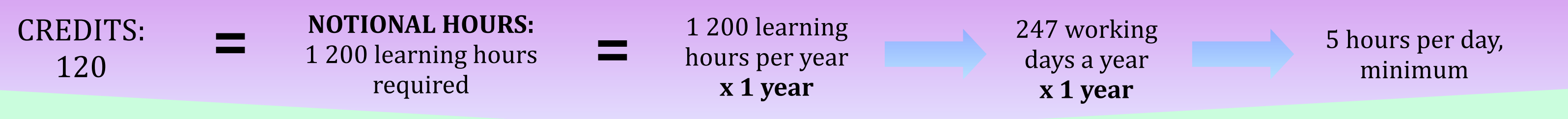

PURPOSE: A Postgraduate Diploma is aimed at enabling working professionals to undertake advanced reflection and development in an area of specialisation.

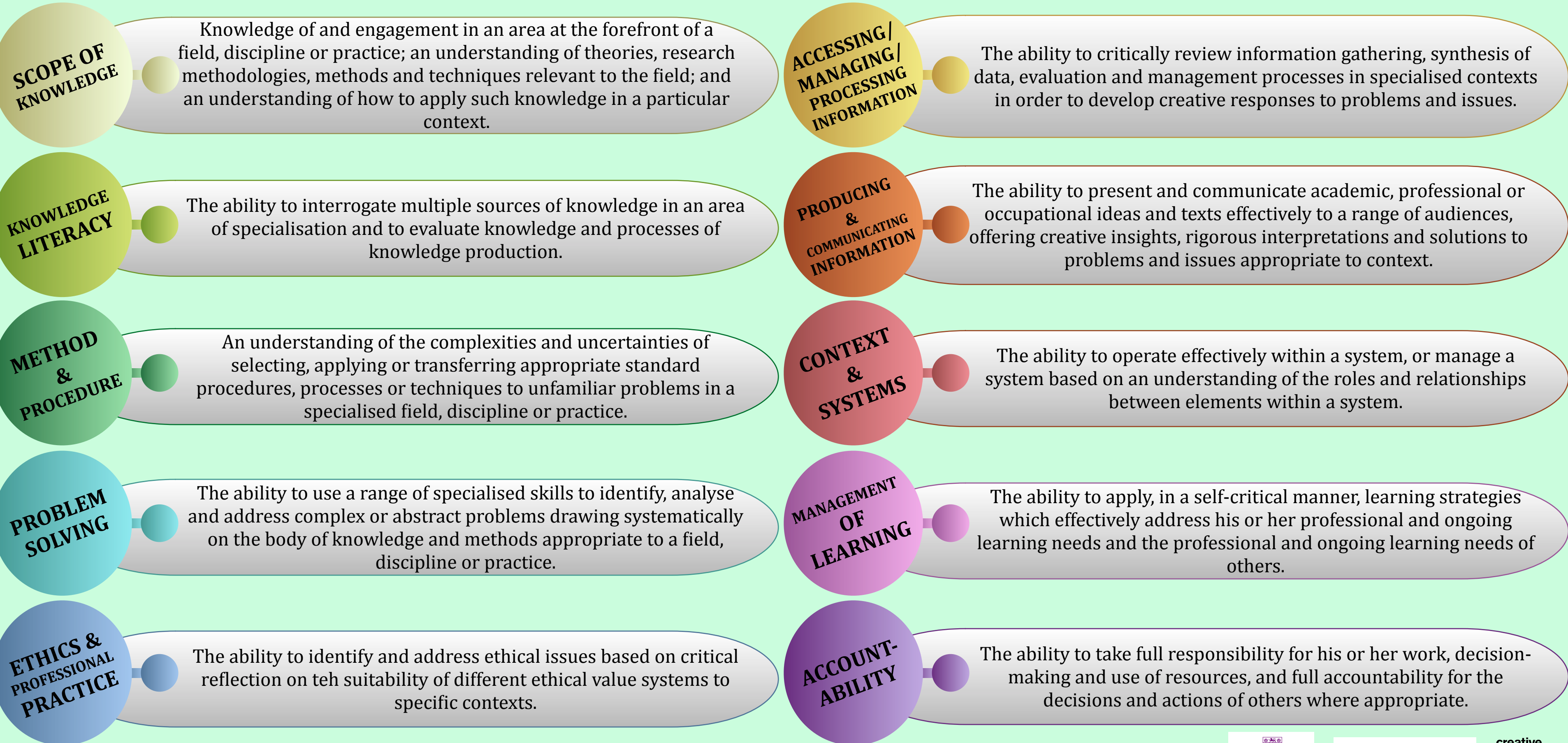
KEY OUTPUT: To demonstrate the ability to demonstrate advanced reflection and development by means of a systematic survey of current thinking, practice and research methods their area of specialisation.

Postgraduate diplomas typically consist of coursework, and may include a small research project. This qualification demands a high level of theoretical engagement and intellectual independence, as well as the ability to relate knowledge to a range of contexts.
