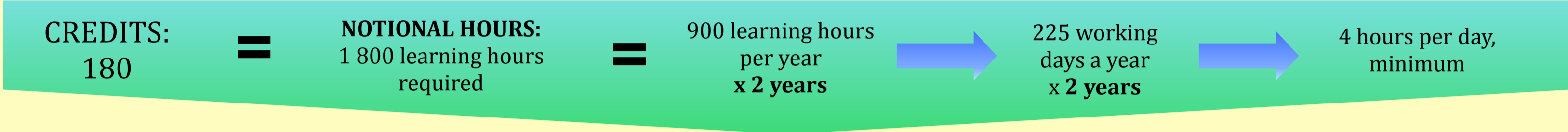

OUTPUTS**

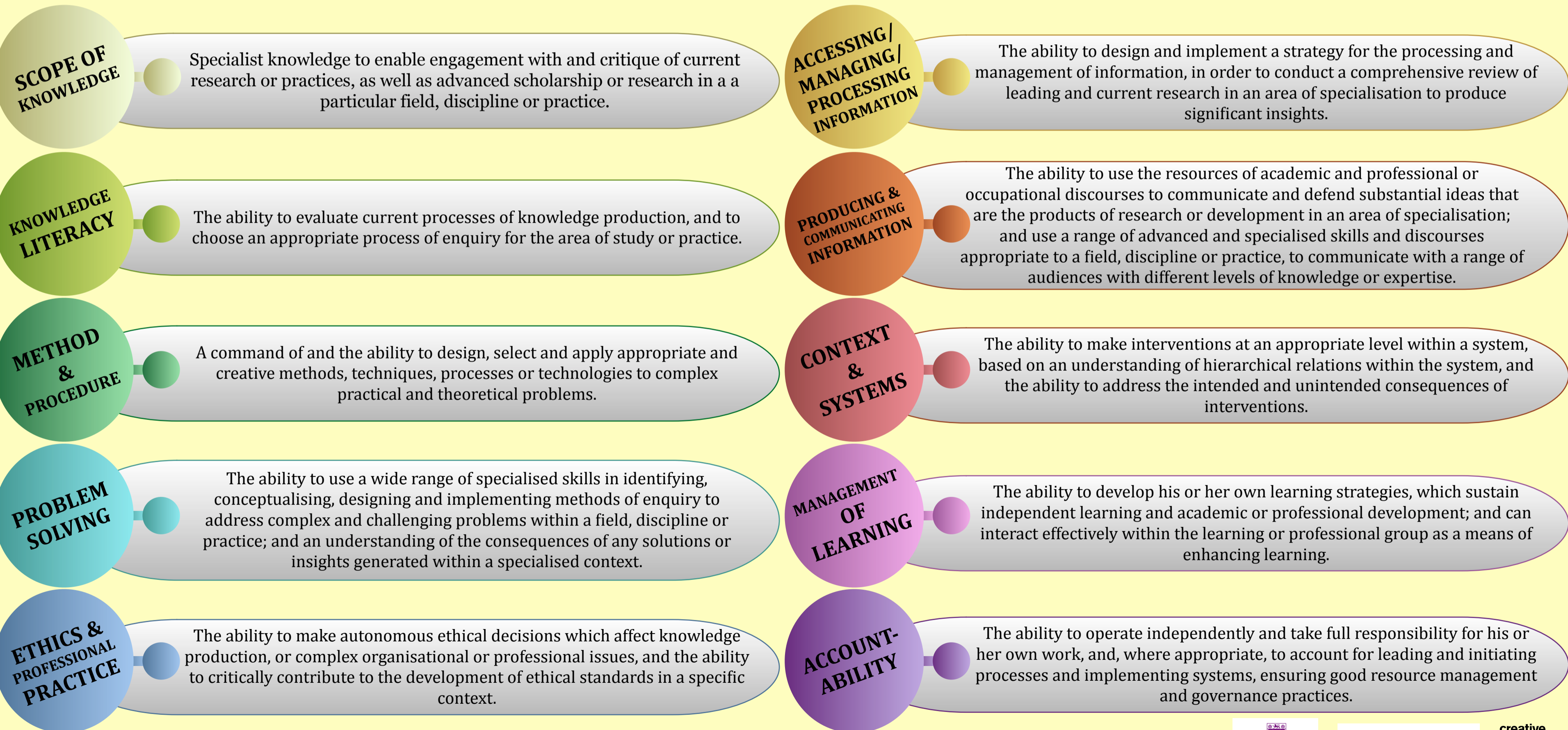
**Master's Degree by Dissertation:** A single advanced research project, culminating in the production and acceptance of a dissertation or other form of research such as a technical report, creative performances or a series of peer reviewed articles and research-equivalent outputs.

**Master's Degree by Coursework & Mini-Dissertation:** A coursework programme requiring a high level of theoretical engagement and intellectual independence, in addition to a research project comprising 60 credits at a Master's level, culminating in a mini-dissertation or research-equivalent output.
